



Student support continues in the Horizons High School Program and Academic Year Program. With Horizons, students can alter the trajectory of their lives—strengthening their families and the community.

Our unique approach combines project-based academic learning, field trips and swimming instruction. For six weeks, students explore science, music, theater and art alongside reading and math instruction to combat what's known as "summer slide." Horizons at Dedham Country Day was founded in 2009 as the first Massachusetts affiliate of the nationwide Horizons network of 60-summer enrichment programs across 17 states. Summer 2021 is shaping up to be an impactful year for Horizons after many of our 150 enrolled students spent an entire year learning remotely or in hybrid models due to COVID-19.
