### Position Summary

Horizons at DCD and Dedham Country Day School Camp are seeking a dedicated and effective certified Lifeguard with a dynamic talent for working with students ages 5 - 13. It is our hope that Horizons summer Lifeguards will return to the program for more than one summer as we continue to work together, support our students, and build the program and the community.

Essential Job Functions: The Lifeguard/Swim Instructor will:

- Supervise swimming activities at the pool and ensure that policies, guidelines, and safety procedures are followed.
- Warn swimmers of improper activities or danger and enforce pool regulations and water safety policies.
- Instruct or assist classes in fundamentals of swimming.
- Administer first aid in the event of injury, rescue swimmers in distress or danger of drowning, and administer CPR and/or artificial respiration, if necessary.
- Evaluate conditions for safety and initiates aquatics emergency action plan as required.
- Inspect pool facilities, equipment, and water to ensure that they are safe and usable.
- Report to the Pool Director

### QUALIFICATIONS:

Red Cross or equivalent Lifeguard certification

The position is seasonal and paid hourly during the seven weeks of the program. The program dates are June 27 –August 9. Hours are 9AM to 4PM daily.
